



**Ms. Suaad Allami** is an Iraqi women's rights leader and attorney. A graduate of Baghdad University School of Law in 1992, she practiced law in Iraqi family courts for seventeen years. She is a founder and Chair for the first legal clinic in Iraq (Women for Progress Center) in Sadir City. In 2008, she was named by the Iraq Women's Foundation as Female Lawyer of the Year. Ms. Allami was one of eight women worldwide to receive from Secretary of State Hillary Clinton and U.S. First Lady Michelle Obama the International Women of Courage Award in March 2009. She was also the honored recipient of the Massachusetts Bar Association Public Service Award in May 2010. In 2009-2010, she was a distinguished Fulbright Hubert Humphrey Fellow at the University of Minnesota Law School. She also completed her Master degree (LLM) in Law and Human Rights from the University of Minnesota Law School in 2010.

Ms. Allami opened and operates the first all female legal clinic in Iraq, supervised five comprehensive women's centers throughout Baghdad (multi services), and executed the first continuing education conference for women lawyers attracting 99 lawyers from across Baghdad. She is a former member of the Baghdad Provincial Council and Sadr City District Council (2004-2009) and author of the By-Laws for the District and Sub-District Councils of Baghdad Province.
