Short title.	<b>1.</b> This Ordinance may be cited as the Sex Disqualification Removal (Legal Profession) Ordinance.
Women entitled to become attomeys- at-law, &c.	<ul> <li>2. A woman shall not be disqualified by reason only of her sex— <ul> <li>(a) from being admitted and enrolled, or from practising, as an attorney-at-law; or</li> <li>(b) from being authorized to practise as a notary by a warrant issued under the provisions of the Notaries Ordinance, or from practising or functioning as a notary under the provisions of that Ordinance or of any other written law; or,</li> </ul></li></ul>

(c) from being appointed, or from functioning, as a Commissioner for Oaths under the provisions of the Oaths Ordinance.
